Travel to the north by former Silk-Road, towards Great Caucasus mountains, Mtiuleti and Khevi areas of Kazbegi municipality. This narrow mountain road has historical name - Georgian Military highway. Enjoy the way, stop for sightseeing in Mtskheta town, visit UNESCO World Heritage Sites Svetitskhoveli and Jvari Monasteries. Visit Ananuri Fortress, Zhinvali reserve, continue to Jvari Pass (2379 m) arrive in Stepantsminda, and witness the majesty of the Kazbegi glacier (5054m). During the tour visit Gveleti waterfall and Dariali Gorge, the mountainous of Khevi, and the masterpiece of medieval architecture - Gergeti Trinity Church.

Itinerary

DAY 1: TBILISI - MTSKHETA - ANANURI -GUDAURI - JVARI PASS - KAZBEGI

9:00 Pick up from **Tbilisi** hotel and depart for **Mtskheta** – the ancient capital of Eastern kingdom of **Georgia**. First stop is at the hill top of **Jvari Monastery**, the prominent viewpoint and the early feudal era church of 6th c. Nextstop for **Mtskheta** town, sightseeing and visit **Svetitskhoveli Cathedral** 11th c. – both sites are includedin UNESCO world heritage list for the high artistic value andoriginal architecture.

Continue to drive along the river Aragvi to Zhinvali reserve and **Ananuri Fortress** 16-17th cc. The fort consists of fortification and residential buildings of **Aragvi Dukes**, who used to control the trade route and protected the country from the North. Ananuri church wall carving is real masterpiece of the medieval artistry.

Drive along the Georgian Military highway to the ski resort **Gudauri** and **Jvari** Pass (2395m). The road is very attractive. Make several photo-stops: at observation platform raised on the edge of the cliff and overlooking a birthplace of roaring river Aragvi, near the highest point on the road marked by 19th c stone obelisk and Kazbegi Travertine Natural Monument.

Arrive in the townlet of <u>Stepantsminda</u> (former name Kazbegi), the centre of <u>Khevi</u> province and main town of Kazbegi municipality. <u>Stepantsminda</u> means St. Stephan and is located at 1700 m above sea level.

Overnight in **Stepantsminda** Hotel.

DAY 2: GERGETI CHURCH- DARIALI GORGE GWELETI WATERFALLS - SNO VALLEY

After breakfast at the local guesthouse, take a walk (approx. time 2.5 hours) to **Gergeti Holy Trinity Church** – an important altar of 14th century, located on the slope of **Mount Kazbegi**. The church facade preserves stone decorations depicting ancient rituals and beliefs.

If we are lucky with weather, we will see **Mount Kazbegi** (5054 m. above sea level). According to the legend, Amirani – a cult hero and a prototype of Greek Prometheus, punished by Gods was chained on the mountain.

Drive to **Dariali** gorge, an important crossing point of **Caucasus** range, which was fortified since 150 BC. Take a walk along the river to **Gweleti** waterfalls, easy upwards trekking (20-25 minutes) and enjoy the views of green valleys and picturesque landscapes.

In the evening return back to **Tbilisi**.
