Get ready for an exciting day of exploration in Tbilisi! Your guide will meet you in the hotel lobby and lead you to the vibrant [Tbilisi Historic District](#). The Old Town is a captivating blend of colors and cultures, where Asia seamlessly meets Europe.

Our first stop is Europe Square, where you'll hop on an aerial cable car for a ride up to [Narikala Fortress](#). From this medieval citadel, enjoy panoramic views of the city, with the ancient curtain walls and St. Nicolas church still standing proudly. Nearby, the entrance to the [Tbilisi Botanical Garden](#) awaits, offering a serene escape into nature. Then, meander through the narrow streets of the old district, passing by landmarks like the Jumah Mosque, medieval Armenian church, and vibrant Azerbaijan carpet shop. Don't miss the chance to marvel at the colorful bathhouses of Abanotubani and the serene Legvtakhevi waterfall.

Next, we'll head to [Chateau Mukhrani](#) wine studio on Meidan Square, where you'll indulge in premium white and red wines while learning about viticulture from our expert sommelier. Then, it's off to Karalashvili's Wine Cellar to sample five exquisite varieties of wine.

- ***Optional:** Extend your wine journey with a tasting session at Schuchmann Wine Studio.

Afterward, we'll drive to the lower station of the [Mtatsminda Funicular](#) on Chonkadze Street and board the tramway to the mountaintop.

Mtatsminda Park awaits you at the summit, offering breathtaking views of Tbilisi from its famous Ferris wheel. As the sun sets, enjoy a delicious dinner paired with Georgian wine, soaking in the serene atmosphere.
