Get ready for an exciting day of exploration in Tbilisi! Your guide will meet you in the hotel lobby and lead you to the vibrant [Tbilisi Historic District](#). The Old Town is a captivating blend of colors and cultures, where Asia seamlessly meets Europe.

Our first stop is Europe Square, where you'll hop on an aerial cable car for a ride up to [Narikala Fortress](#). From this medieval citadel, enjoy panoramic views of the city, with the ancient curtain walls and St. Nicolas church still standing proudly. Nearby, the entrance to the [Tbilisi Botanical Garden](#) awaits, offering a serene escape into nature. Then, meander through the narrow streets of the old district, passing by landmarks like the Jumah Mosque, medieval Armenian church, and vibrant Azerbaijan carpet shop. Don't miss the chance to marvel at the colorful bathhouses of Abanotubani.

Next, we'll head to Karalashvili's Wine Cellar to sample five exquisite varieties of wine. Hailing from the picturesque region of Kakheti, Georgia, the Karalashvili family name carries a rich and storied heritage. Recognized with the prestigious title of "Prince" by King George VII of Kartl-Kakheti in the 14th century, the Karalashvili family has been passionately crafting fine wines since 1396.

Afterward, we'll drive to 8000 vintages wine-bar where you have opportunity to taste Georgian wines specially chosen by professional sommeliers. The place offers big variety of wines of all regions of Georgia from both industrial and natural wine producers.

Next head to the lower station of the [Mtatsminda Funicular](#) on Chonkadze Street and board the tramway to the mountaintop.
